



RANCHO BERNARDO HIGH PTSA SCHOLARSHIP FOR GRADUATING SENIORS

The Rancho Bernardo High School PTSA offers Graduating High School Senior Scholarships to acknowledge the achievements of high school seniors for volunteer service in the school and community.

AVAILABILITY

RBHS PTSA scholarship funds are available to high school seniors graduating in June of the current academic year. The scholarship award is to be used during fall semester/quarter following high school graduation at an accredited college or university, community college, or trade/technical school.

QUALIFICATIONS

This scholarship recognizes volunteer service in the school and community and does not have a grade point average restriction or requirement. The applicant must be a member of the RBHS PTSA to apply.

APPLICATION

The application and accompanying reference forms may be obtained from the RBHS PTSA Scholarships webpage. The final application packet must include the following:

- 1. A three-page, double-spaced essay describing the following:
 - Any PTSA responsibility you may have had during high school. Your career plans, goals, objective, and any other information you feel would be valuable to the selection committee
 - All school service-related activities including any service you have provided to others in your school
 - Your volunteer service in the community.
- 2. Two reference forms and letters in sealed envelopes:
 - Each reference must be a RBHS faculty member or a community volunteer leader with whom the student applicant has served. Neither reference can be related to the student.
 - The letter must be written specifically for this scholarship application.
 - Copies of recommendation letters for college admission are not acceptable.
 - Each completed reference form and letter should be given to the applicant in a sealed envelope.

3. A completed application form

DUE DATE

The application packet must be submitted to PTSA Mailbox in the main office no later than the end of the school day on May 1st. The application will not be considered if it is received after May 1st or if any of the required materials is missing.

Each applicant's information is kept confidential. Recipients are selected by members of the Rancho Bernardo High PTSA Scholarship and Grant Committee. All applicants will be notified of their standing by May 30th. A check for the scholarship will be sent directly to the recipient and will be made payable to the student and the college, university, or trade/technical school at which the student will be enrolled in the fall.
